

Cumberland County Association of Principals and Assistant Principals Scholarship Application 2017-2018

The Cumberland County Association of Principals and Assistant Principals (CCAPAP) is proud to be able to present scholarships to qualifying Cumberland County Schools (CCS) high school seniors to help them defray the cost of higher education. Each year the association holds a fundraiser to accumulate funds so that we may offer a scholarship to each high school in our district.

To be considered eligible for this scholarship, students must:

- Be a 2017-2018 Cumberland County Schools high school senior
- Maintain a minimum weighted 2.5 GPA
- Complete the essay portion of the scholarship as directed
- Include an official transcript with the application
- Include a current report card with the application
- Complete the Scholarship Application
- Turn the completed packet in by the scholarship deadline to the specified location

Students who are chosen to receive a scholarship will be notified in June. Scholarships will be awarded to one recipient from each comprehensive high school and one, collectively, from all non-comprehensive high schools in Cumberland County. The amount of the scholarships will be determined by the amount of funds generated at CACPAP's annual fundraiser. CCAPAP's goal is to raise sufficient funds to award each recipient a \$1,000.00 scholarship. All applicants will be notified regarding the outcome of the scholarship process.

The scholarship and all requested information must be postmarked OR delivered in person to the main office at Stoney Point Elementary School (7411 Rockfish Road) no later than 4:00 pm on Thursday, April 19, 2018. Late applications will not be accepted.
